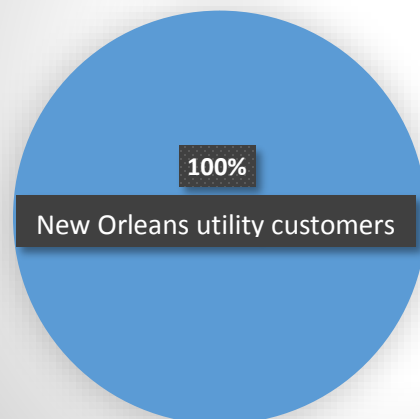

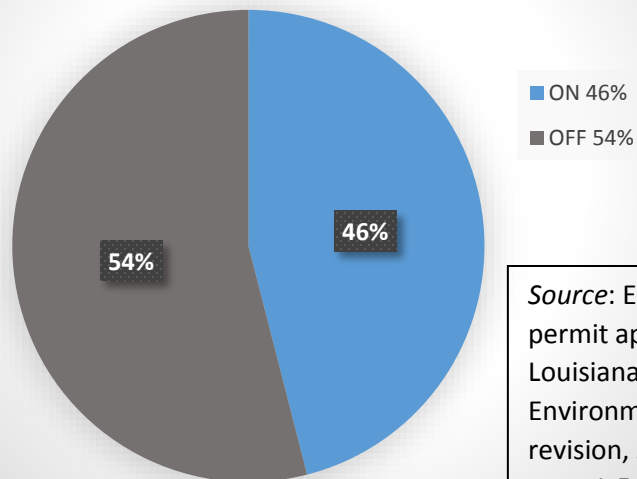
Who would pay the \$216 million

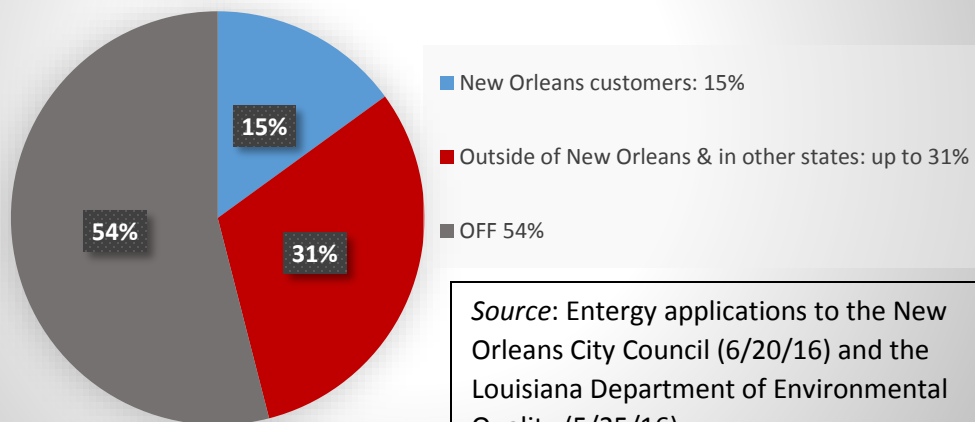
